ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY



- Comply with applicable legal requirements such as The Canadian Environmental Protection Act 1999 (CEPA); all provincial regulations and laws with respect to: Clean Air Act (CAA), the Clean Water Act (CWA), the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA), Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA).
- Adopt Risk Management Processes to minimize the risks of environmental damage.
- Assess on a regular basis the environmental impact of all our operations;
- Set environmental objectives with the aim of continual improvement and prevention of pollution.
- Ensure that the Policy is used to provide the framework to manage our environmental objectives and targets.
- Minimize waste, noise and emissions to atmosphere in all parts of our service delivery.
- Reduce the environmental effects our operations have on habitats, species and on natural habitats.
- Ensure that all waste, particularly hazardous waste such as contaminated soil, are tested, transported and disposed of in an environmentally acceptable manner, in accordance with local and provincial regulations;
- Establish emergency response procedures to deal with accidental pollution that align with appropriate authorities.
- Encourage employee involvement in environmental action through re-use or recycle packaging wherever practical.
- Work with reputable Waste Management Systems partners to further ensure sound disposal or recycling of materials.
